ACCOMPLISHMENTS: ASN’S YEAR IN REVIEW: 2024

A Year of Growth, Service, and Community Impact

The year 2024 was an extraordinary period for the ASN as it continued its unwavering commitment to supporting the Afghan-American community. Throughout the year, ASN worked diligently to provide essential services, education programs, employment assistance & career support, legal & immigration assistance, wraparound services and community-building initiatives. These initiatives & services played a vital role in helping Afghan families rebuild their lives, gain self-sufficiency, and contribute to their new communities.

In the Year 2024, ASN provided support to **1085 unique clients**, resulting in a **total of 12,746 services touchpoints**. Notably, 51% of the beneficiaries were female, demonstrating ASN’s success in expanding its reach and creating impactful services that uplift and empower Afghan women within the community.
