

During the third quarter (Q3) of 2025 (July, August, September), the Afghan Support Network (ASN) continued expanding its impact, reaching 661 unique clients through over 9,671 service touchpoints across Oregon and SW Washington, reinforcing our mission to empower, uplift, and serve Afghan and immigrant families through culturally grounded programs.

ASN provided support to 661 unique clients, resulting in total of 9,671 services touchpoints across housing, employment, legal & immigration assistance, healthcare navigation, case management, food-aid, mutual-aid, Driver-Ed, ESOL, and diverse Educational Programs for children, youth and adults. ASN facilitated \$112,937 in direct support and \$77830 (combined total \$190,767) in housing and rental assistance, helping 150 households & families secure stable living conditions, while 14 job placements contributed to economic empowerment within the Afghan-American community. ASN's English (ESOL) Program has 117 students with 64 monthly classes, while our cultural events has had combined 954 participants. In total our education programs had more than 4,611 learning sessions for 488 students.

The quarter also featured vibrant community engagement through major events such as the Annual Afghan Cultural Celebration, Voices of the Homeland: Poetry Night, Chai & Paint, and the ASN Job & Resource Fair, engaging more than 950 participants. These gatherings strengthened cultural identity, connection, and belonging within the Afghan-American and broader Oregonian community.

As ASN continues its journey into the final quarter of 2025, we remain deeply committed to empowering Afghan and immigrant families through culturally specific, community-driven programs that promote stability, education, and opportunity.
